

AGREEMENT IN LIEU OF AN EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL

In lieu of submission of an erosion and sediment control plan for the construction of this single family dwelling, I agree to comply with any reasonable requirements determined necessary by employees of Pittsylvania County, representing the Erosion and Sediment Control Program Administrator. Such requirements shall be based on the conservation standards contained in Pittsylvania County's Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance, and shall represent the minimum practices necessary to provide adequate control of erosion and sedimentation on or resulting from this project.

As a minimum, all denuded areas on the lot shall be stabilized within 7 days of final grading with permanent vegetation or a protective ground cover suitable for the time of year.

**MINIMUM MEASURES SPECIFIED BY THE PLAN APPROVING AUTHORITY:**

- 1) Install culvert under entrance road.
- 2) Place rip-rap at outlet of the culvert.
- 3) Provide culvert inlet protection as required.
- 4) Place gravel on the entrance and parking area immediately.
- 5) Grade slopes to minimum 3:1 ratio.
- 6) Sediment filtration measures such as silt fence, straw bales or brush barriers must be provided to keep sediment from adjacent properties, drainage ways or streams. Vegetated buffer strips may be allowed where run-off is sheet flow only. Minimum buffer strip width is 20 feet.
- 7) Seed and mulch all disturbed areas at the following rate per 1,000 sq. ft.:
  - 8 lbs. Ky.31 or other tall fescue
  - 100 lbs. lime
  - 25 lbs 10-10-10 fertilizer
  - 2 bales straw mulch (70-90 lbs).
- 8) Runoff must not be concentrated and re-directed onto adjacent properties in a manner which will damage those properties.

Additional measures may be specified if determined necessary by the Program Administrator.

I further understand that failure to comply with such requirements within three (3) working days following notice by the representatives of Pittsylvania County could result in citation for violation of the Pittsylvania County Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance.
